## **2018 Hearts Grants**

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### **Culturally Sensitive Neuropsychology Testing \$1,160**

Purchase culturally appropriate testing tools to reduce disparities in care for monolingual patients.

### **Comfort Food for Patients \$2,000**

Provide comfort and fulfill nutritional needs of hospitalized patients by offering specialty food tailored to individuals with cultural, emotional or religious needs.

### **Pediatric Immobilization for X-Rays \$3,500**

Improve image quality of x-rays and minimize radiation exposure to children by providing comfort during radiographic procedures with immobilization devices.

### **Enhancing Provider Skills in Addiction Treatment \$6,340**

Enhance inpatient provider skills in evidenced-based addiction treatment to improve the quality of care provided for patients with substance use disorder.

### **Train-the-Trainer Navigation & Health Coaching \$6,350**

Work with an increased number of high-risk patients in encouraging healthy behavior changes by training students to become health navigators.

### **Healing and Wellness Support Group for African American Men \$6,800**

Develop and restore equity through shared experiences among male African American staff and clinicians at ZSFG.

### **Learning Activities for Children's Health Center \$8,000**

Provide learning activity cubes and boards in waiting and exam rooms.

### **Transforming Trauma Care for Victims of Violent Crime \$8,000**

Improve treatment for survivors of violent crime by conducting trainings for new clinical staff.

### **Community Youth Advisory Council \$9,001**

Establish a community youth advisory council that will guide best practices for delivery of youth-centered care.

### **Opioid Treatment through Yoga Therapy \$9,310**

Enhance the quality and effectiveness of opioid treatment by promoting opportunities for patient participation in on-campus yoga.

**Multicultural Breastfeeding Education Video \$9,900**

Enhance the breastfeeding program for ZSFG's patients by producing multilingual and multicultural educational videos.

**Relationship Centered Communication \$10,400**

Promote deeper communication and facilitation skill-building across racial and ethnic differences among staff and patients.

**Integrative Strategies for Nursing Student Success \$10,600**

Support the success of underrepresented minority nursing students through the development of a program that addresses academic, social, and self-efficacy barriers.

**MHRC Transitional Enrichment Program \$11,910**

Decrease the number of returning clients with mental health challenges through vocational training as well as coping and transitional skills for greater success in the community.

**Pediatrics Brush, Book, & Bed Initiative \$13,404**

Promote early literacy through the purchase of books and pediatric oral health kits.

**Equitable Care for Sexual and Gender Minority Patients \$13,435**

Support training and promote a more inclusive and welcoming environment for all patients regardless of gender or sexual orientation.

**Early Language & Brain Development \$13,900**

Promote early literacy and brain development by providing parents with educational materials about the importance of reading to children beginning at birth.

**Hypertension Control and Equity in Primary Care \$14,400**

Distribute blood pressure home monitoring devices to Black African American patients for self-tracking and hypertension control.

**Nutrition Kits for Dialysis Patients \$18,750**

Empower dialysis patients in making beneficial food choices by providing Nutrition Wellness Kits.

**Innovating the Future of HIV Care \$20,000**

Deliver novel and high-impact services to older HIV-positive patients through the Golden Compass program.

**Breast Cancer Survivorship Group \$20,220**

Assist breast cancer survivors with the transition from specialty to primary care.

**Food and Nutrition Heartbeats Project \$22,000**

Support the Heartbeats Project in improving ZSFG's food experience for patients, visitors, and staff.

**The Latino Grief Support Equity Initiative \$25,000**

Provide grief and loss support groups for ZSFG's Latino community.

**Enhancing Emergency Medicine Clinical Armamentarium \$26,667**

Ensure providers are abreast of the latest evidence-based literature and practices for managing the vast array of emergency medicine pathology by developing a medical education curriculum.
