**KIM MEREDITH
NAMED CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF
SAN FRANCISCO GENERAL HOSPITAL FOUNDATION**

SAN FRANCISCO (May 14, 2020) – Following an extensive search, the **San Francisco General Hospital Foundation** (the Foundation) has named **Kim Meredith** as the organization’s new Chief Executive Officer, effective Monday, June 15, 2020. Meredith, overseeing every aspect of the Foundation and working closely with the San Francisco General Hospital Foundation Board of Directors, will be chief strategist, fundraiser, and advocate for one of the country’s top public hospitals, the **Priscilla Chan and Mark Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital and Trauma Center** (Zuckerberg San Francisco General). The Foundation provides philanthropic support for vital programs and initiatives at Zuckerberg San Francisco General which might otherwise go unfunded.

“Kim’s leadership experience in fundraising and strategic planning will be paramount as we move forward in the Foundation’s ongoing support of a diverse range of programs at Zuckerberg San Francisco General,” said **John Bell, San Francisco General Hospital Foundation Board President**. “We look forward to Kim’s leadership, direction, and fresh ideas in the months and years ahead as we prepare for the next chapter in healthcare at Zuckerberg San Francisco General and in philanthropy for the Foundation.”

“This global pandemic is unlike anything we have faced in our lifetimes. For me, the call to action to lead the Foundation at this time was an opportunity I simply could not let pass. There is remarkable urgency to the work the hospital and the Foundation are doing in this unprecedented moment and I look forward to partnering with the Foundation staff, Board, and donors as we navigate the uncharted waters ahead,” said Ms. Meredith.

Meredith joins the Foundation from Stanford University’s Center for Philanthropy and Civil Society (Stanford PACS) where she was the inaugural Executive Director and now will transition immediately to its Advisory Board. She currently sits on the Board of Directors of the George Lucas Education Foundation and Essential Access Health, the Laura Arrillaga-Andreessen Foundation (LAAF) Advisory Board, and the YPO Pacific U.S. Gold Regional Board. Meredith held a recent six-year board term on Silicon Valley Social Venture Fund (SV2).

Meredith played a vital role in building what is now a vibrant academic center that amplifies thought leadership to inform philanthropy and strengthen civil society, democracy, ethics, and technology. During her nearly 11-year tenure at Stanford PACS, Meredith was responsible for strategic leadership, financial performance, and consistent organizational growth, including scaling the center through the expansion of research and programmatic initiatives. Meredith led her team to acquire and grow *Stanford Social Innovation Review (SSIR)*, the pre-eminent journal for the social sector, and founded the Stanford Center at Peking University. Under her leadership, Stanford PACS also founded and expanded signature, field-leading convenings, like the Philanthropy Innovation Summit and First Principles Forum.

Prior to joining Stanford PACS, Meredith served as the Chief Development Officer for Planned Parenthood Federation of America in New York City. Before that, she served as the Chief Operating Officer at Planned Parenthood Golden Gate in San Francisco. Meredith launched her business career in corporate America at AT&T, after graduating from Stanford University with a B.A. in Economics. In 2005, Meredith received a fellowship to the Stanford Graduate School of Business Executive Program for Nonprofit Leaders, and in 2018 was sponsored for the UC Berkeley – Haas School of Business, Berkeley Corporate Board Workshop.
