The Hospital has served our community through well over a century of natural disasters and public

ZSFG is a beacon of public health leadership and equity, with treatment protocols





developed here now used all over the world. And, as the only Level 1 Trauma Center serving San Francisco and northern San Mateo counties, ZSFG is always here should you or I experience an emergency. The Hospital's continuing legacy is equitable access, compassionate treatment, and extraordinary health care for all. And now, Zuckerberg San Francisco General is planning for the next 150 years.

- 1,200 babies delivered annually
- The city's ambulances deliver **30%** of their patients to ZSFG
- 24-hour, 7-days-a-week trauma care, social services, and psych intake
- #1 globally in HIV/AIDS care
- Treated more than **30%** of all COVID-19 patients in San Francisco
- 70% of inpatients are uninsured or underinsured
