A 20-year Investment in Public Health



With 20 years of impact, the Foundation's Equity & Innovation Grants have created a legacy of investing in the people and programs at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital and Trauma Center that asks, "How can we better care for our patients?"

This year, the Foundation gathered with supporters and past grantees to celebrate the collective impact of more than \$14 million invested through nearly 600 grants, creating a pipeline of innovations in public health. From securing state-of-the-art equipment to funding pilot programs, these grants have shaped public health in San Francisco.

This year's ceremony also announced the 2025 grantees: the Eye Clinic and the Healthy Lifestyles Clinic. Each program will receive a capacity-building grant of \$100,000, made possible by the generous multi-year support of our partners at BMO. By focusing on long-term support for these two programs, this year's grantees will expand services to better serve their patients, raising the bar on the standard of care at ZSFG.

ZSFG Emergency Triage Team Awarded for Innovation



As the city's only Level 1 trauma center, the Emergency Department at ZSFG is a critical resource for all of San Francisco. But for patients relying on

the emergency room for less urgent care, long wait times can lead many to leave without seeing a doctor. Recognizing the need to streamline care from the waiting room, a team of nurses and physicians at ZSFG came together to redesign triage to meet the needs of both staff and patients.

The Emergency Department Triage team at ZSFG was recognized this year by the California Association of Public Hospitals and Health Systems for these efforts, celebrating the innovative way this team combined patient and staff surveys, data analysis, and collaborative design processes to improve patient experience and care for more patients right from the time they arrive in the waiting room.

The 8th Annual NOVA12 Walk

Nearly a decade ago, staff at ZSFG's AVON Breast Cancer Center came together to launch a breast cancer walk to raise funds for patients undergoing treatment in San Francisco. With a deep commitment to the patients they serve, this local fundraiser also raises awareness of the inequities seen in late-stage diagnoses and encourages patients across the city to take advantage of early screenings.

This year's NOVA12 Walk, covering 12 miles in honor of the approximately 12% of women who will develop invasive breast cancer in their lifetimes, brought together more than 125 walkers and volunteers to raise \$70,000 to support patients in need.

A New Heart Sculpture Brightens Up Union Square

This fall, the Foundation installed its latest Hearts in San Francisco sculpture in downtown San Francisco, bringing vibrant colors to the corner of Powell and Geary Streets. In partnership with the Union Square Alliance, this latest Heart, titled *SŌL* and designed by local artist Dev Heyrana, was unveiled during a special ceremony. The event celebrated more than twenty years of collaboration between the Hearts in San

Francisco project and Union Square, which hosts four large heart sculptures every year. Attended by elected officials, local business owners, and Foundation supporters, this unveiling showcased the legacy of this public art project.
